



The Gautam Buddha Central Library provides access to about 7000 e-Journals to the BBAU fraternity through e-ShodhSindhu Consortium of MHRD and other e-Resources. INFED Remote Access Service for BBAU fraternity to seamlessly access of these full-text e-Journals/e-Resources from outside the BBAU campus has been established. The website for accessing these e-resources is <https://idb.bbau.ac.in>. The INFED Remote Access system has been established by the Gautam Buddha Central Library with the support of INFLIBNET. The e-Resources has been linked with this webpage for easy Username and password access. have been provided to the user through e-mail to access the e-Resources 24X7.

- In the list please select **India: INFLIBNET Access Management Federation (INFED)**.

### Step-4:

- After selecting INFLINET, you will find a list of Indian University/Institutions. Select **Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University**.
- It may ask username and password or automatically login. If ask than please enter username and password, accept it. Now you will be able to access the full-text journals of ACS.

## Steps to access e-Resources of JSTOR


### Step-1:

**Steps-2:** The following page will be opened, here please choose any option as per your choice among the three provided options than click on **Accept** button.



**Step-3:** Please click on **Find My institution** at “Looking for your institution?” as shown below.




**Step-4:**


